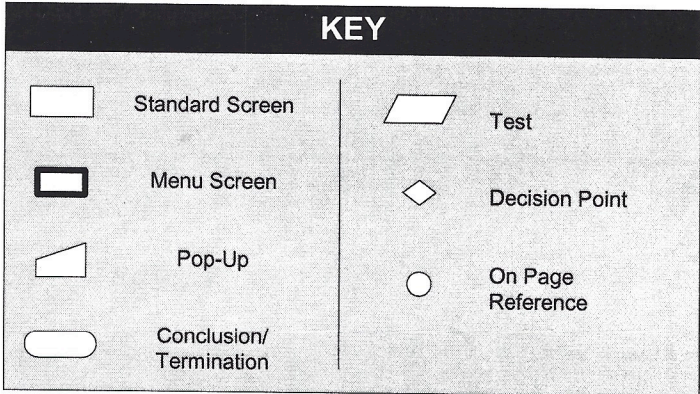
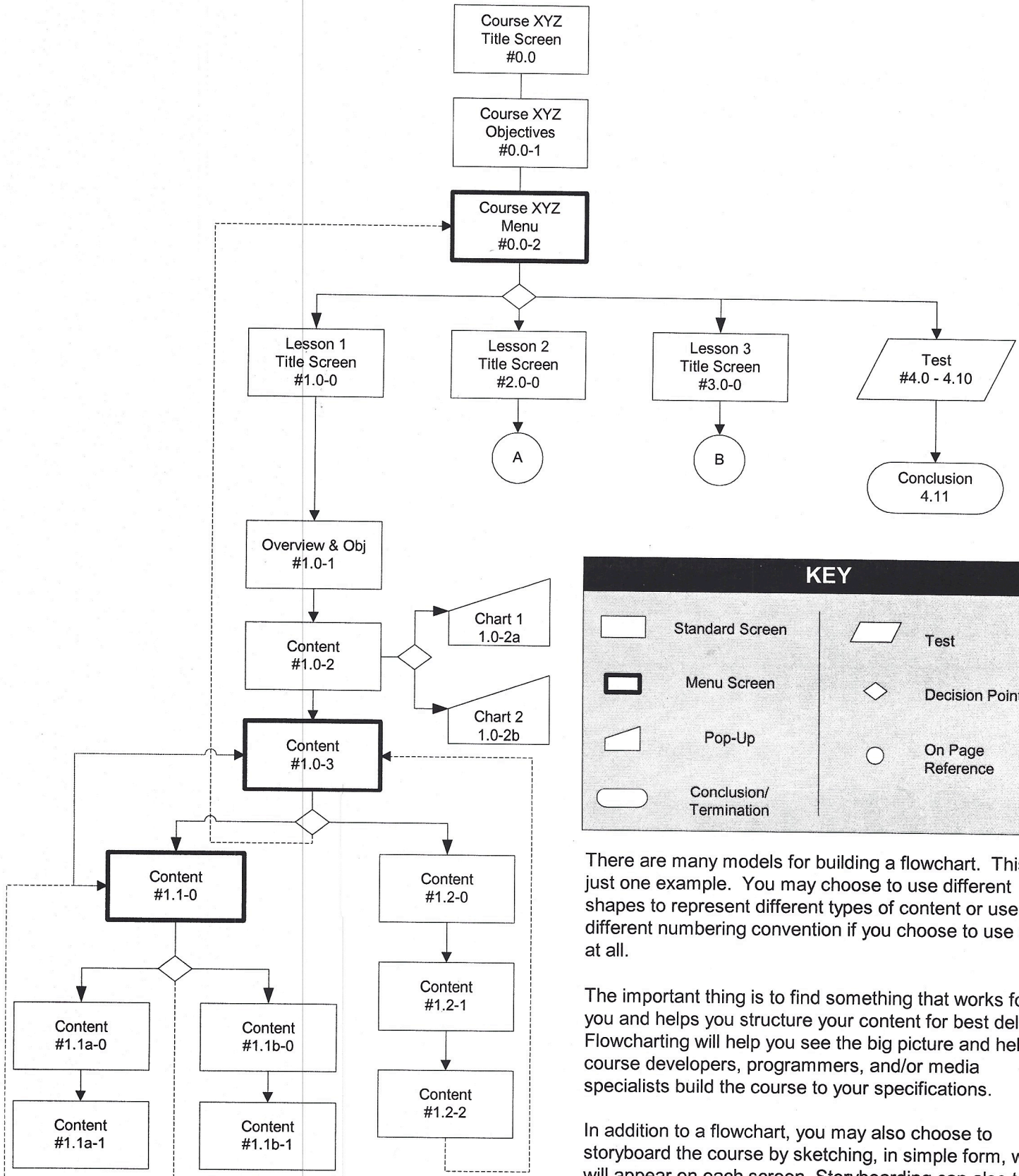


EXAMPLE FLOWCHART For Self-Paced Online Learning



There are many models for building a flowchart. This is just one example. You may choose to use different shapes to represent different types of content or use a different numbering convention if you choose to use one at all.

The important thing is to find something that works for you and helps you structure your content for best delivery. Flowcharting will help you see the big picture and help the course developers, programmers, and/or media specialists build the course to your specifications.

In addition to a flowchart, you may also choose to storyboard the course by sketching, in simple form, what will appear on each screen. Storyboarding can also take on several levels or complexity. For example, the storyboard may be used to document the actual content, navigation, image, and timing requirements.
